Instructions for Reproducing Our Analyses and Robustness Checks using PetersMcGuireStataDoFile.do and PetersMcGuireData.xls

August 8, 2011

- 1. Download PetersMcGuireStataDoFile.do
- 2. Drop it into the ado folder within your Stata application folder
- 3. Download PetersMcGuireData.xls
- 4. Open PetersMcGuireData.xls and copy cells A3 to GY216 only
- 5. Open Stata and paste the contents of the buffer into the Stata data editor
- 6. Close the data editor
- 7. Open PetersMcGuireStataDoFile.do by going to File/Open within Stata. Make sure you make visible "Stata D0-Files" at the bottom of the window.
- 8. Wait two minutes (no kidding) for PetersMcGuireStataDoFile.do to load. You have to be patient. It's 31 single-spaced pages of code in a tiny font.
- 9. On August 8, 2011, PetersMcGuireStataDoFile.do in conjunction with PetersMcGuireData.xls ran without a hitch. If you follow these instructions exactly, it should work without a hitch for you too.
